



COLTS CLOSE OUT WINNING SEASON!

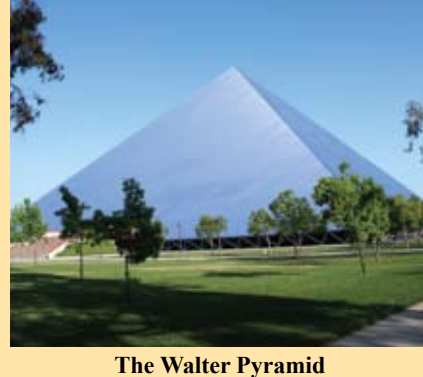


The entire CSC team would like to congratulate the Indianapolis Colts on their 2010 AFC Championship title and Super Bowl appearance.

CSC provides 24-hour security and game day event staff, ticket takers, and ushers for all Colts home games at Lucas Oil Stadium, a CSC client since 2002. Lucas Oil Stadium was recently recognized as the Sports Facility of the Year by Street and Smith's Sports Business Journal. The selling points for this award were the stadium's multifunctional design for both the NFL and the NCAA Final Four, its retractable roof, its operable window that provides a view of downtown Indianapolis, and its field-level suites in the end zone. Lucas Oil Stadium will be the site for the 2012 Super Bowl and the host venue for upcoming NCAA basketball events, including the 2010 Men's Final Four and the 2011 Women's Final Four. The stadium also hosts other sports tournaments and a myriad of conventions, exhibitions and trade shows. CSC provides services for Lucas Oil Stadium under the guidance of Stadium Director, **Mike Fox**. ■

NEW PARTNERSHIP WITH CSULB

Bowden coached his final game in front of a record-breaking crowd of 84,129 at Jacksonville Municipal Stadium with CSC providing services under the direction of SMG Assistant General Manager **Tracey Evans** and President of the Gator Bowl Association **Rick Catlett**.

PHILADELPHIA HOSTS 110TH ARMY/NAVY GAME



CSC Philadelphia was proud to welcome the 110th Army vs. Navy game, held on December 12th at Lincoln Financial Field. In front of more than 69,000 fans, Secretary of Defense Robert Gates flipped the opening coin and fireworks were set off during introductions as both teams stormed the field waving their school flags. With fans standing and cheering the entire game, it was clear how much the rivalry meant to both sides. In the end, Navy won 17-3 and was awarded the Commander-In-Chief's Trophy for the seventh straight year, which is awarded to the team with the best record among the three service academies. CSC Philadelphia provided crowd management services and security for the gates, field, perimeter, and teams. With many dignitaries in attendance, CSC also provided escorts for the Secretary of Defense Robert Gates, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Admiral Michael M. McHugh, Secretary of the Army John M. McHugh, and Army Chief of Staff George W. Casey. ■
