



NEW CONTRACT WITH PHILADELPHIA UNION



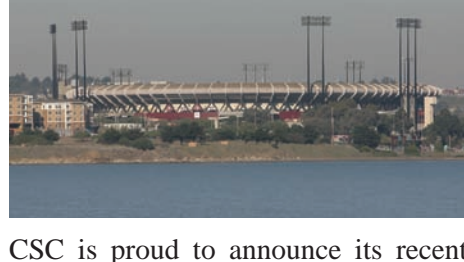
CSC is excited to announce the recent signing of a 3-year contract with Global Spectrum, PPL Park, and Major League Soccer's newest team, the Philadelphia Union. Located in Chester, Pennsylvania, PPL Park is a brand new state-of-the-art stadium that will serve as the home field for the Union. With a seating capacity of 18,500 for soccer matches and approximately 22,000 for concerts, the stadium is expected to "Kick Start Chester" by bringing renewed life and vitality to the historic city. PPL Park sits on the Chester waterfront and is the catalyst for the spectacular \$500 million waterfront revitalization project.

The Global Spectrum team opening PPL Park includes General Manager **Mike Scanlon**, Operations Manager **Jim McDonald**, and Event Manager **Steve Shultz**. CSC will also be working closely with Philadelphia Union President **Tom Veit** and the entire staff in order to help create one of the best soccer venues in the league. CSC will be providing services for gate searches, field and locker room coverage, general and premium seating security, and the 24-hour command center security. Global Spectrum has also added the services of Apex Security Group, a CSC affiliate company, to provide security for all exterior lots in the city of Chester. ■

3-YEAR CONTRACT WITH GLOBAL SPECTRUM AND THE LIACOURAS CENTER



CSC is pleased to announce its three-year contract renewal with Global Spectrum and the Liacouras Center. Located in Philadelphia, the Liacouras Center is a 10,200 seat entertainment venue that hosts a variety of events, including concerts, sporting events, comedy shows, college and high school commencements, and family shows. The Liacouras Center is also home to the Division I Temple Owls men's and women's basketball teams as well as the Philadelphia Kixx indoor soccer team. CSC will provide crowd management, gate and perimeter security, access control, and VIP escorts for all events at the Liacouras Center under the direction of General Manager, **Fran Rodowicz**, and Assistant General Manager, **James Grafstrom**. ■

CSC ROCKS THE COACHELLA MUSIC FESTIVAL

The 2010 Coachella Music Festival returned to the desert in Indio, California April 16-18 for three packed days of eclectic performances. Featuring many genres of music, including alternative rock, electronic, and hip hop, the event has several stages and tents throughout the grounds with music playing continuously. Also held in Indio is California's Country Music Festival, Stagecoach, which took place the weekend following Coachella. This year's Stagecoach lineup included the biggest names in country music, including Keith Urban, Brooks & Dunn, Sugarland, and Toby Keith. CSC Los Angeles and Orange County teamed together to provide over 4,100 staff members combined for Coachella and Stagecoach, including 24-hour security for the campgrounds, supporting infrastructure security, and bicycle patrol operations. Coachella and Stagecoach were both presented by Goldenvoice. ■



ROCK ON THE RANGE 2010



The 4th annual Rock on the Range music festival returned May 22-23 to Columbus Crew Stadium in Ohio. One of the nation's premier rock and heavy metal festivals, this year's Rock on the Range featured 38 bands, 3 separate stages, and more than 60,000 fans. CSC Columbus provided over 300 staff members throughout the 2-day festival, which featured bands such as the Deftones, Rob Zombie, Godsmack, and the return of Limp Bizkit. Despite the unpredictability of the Columbus weather, CSC's staff provided excellent coverage of the event, including full searches at the gates, backstage coverage, perimeter control, and floor and barricade coverage for the three stages. CSC has provided services for Columbus Crew Stadium since 2003. ■

PHILADELPHIA HOSTS 116th ANNUAL PENN RELAYS

The 116th annual Penn Relays took place April 22-24 at the University of Pennsylvania's Franklin Field with CSC providing security, ticket taking, bag checks, access control, and ushering services. This year's races drew a record crowd of more than 117,000 fans over the three days, many of whom attended to catch a glimpse of Olympic gold medal winner Usain Bolt compete in the 4x100. Not one to disappoint, Bolt won the race with a time of 37.90, a Penn Relays record. The entire three days of competition ran very smoothly and CSC Philadelphia Branch Manager JP Hayslip was very appreciative of his hard-working staff and the great management from **Peggy Kowalski**, University of Pennsylvania Associate Athletic Director. ■

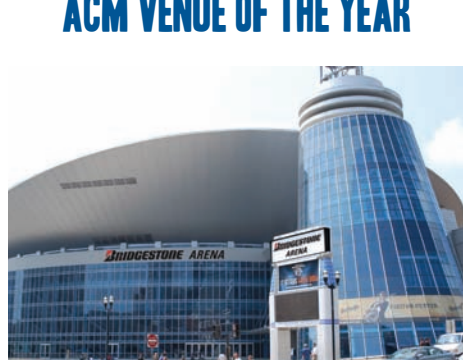
CSC MEMPHIS HELPS FIGHT HUNGER

DALLAS HOSTS WINDPOWER CONFERENCE

The annual WINDPOWER Conference & Exhibition was held May 23-26 at the Dallas Convention Center. Hosted by the American Wind Energy Association (AWEA), this premier event showcases opportunities for new players to enter the wind market and addresses America's economic, energy and climate challenges. This year's conference program included over 300 speakers and moderators, 150 poster presentations, and over 50 sessions on leading wind energy topics. VIP speakers included Senators, Governors and former President George W. Bush.

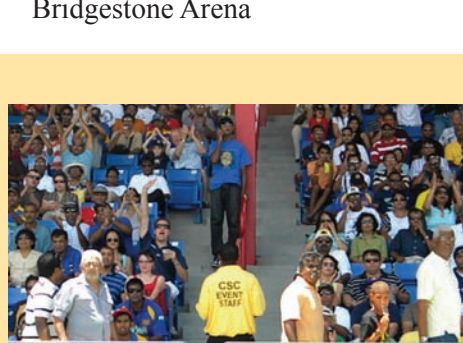
IOWA EVENTS CENTER HOSTS SELL-OUT CROWDS
